GFWC-Charlotte provides donation to Summer Musical Theatre Camp at the Charlotte Performing Arts Center

The General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC)-Charlotte has generously donated \$100 toward the tuition of four Charlotte residents that are interested in attending the Summer Musical Theatre Camp at the Charlotte Performing Arts Center July 5 – 16. The money will be awarded as a partial scholarship in \$25 increments. In order to fairly allocate the money, the directors of the Charlotte camp are having an essay contest to determine who will receive the awards.

Charlotte residents entering grades 2 through 12 who are interested in applying for tuition assistance should write a one-page essay explaining why they want to attend the musical theatre camp and how they feel the camp will benefit them. Interested participants entering grades 2 through 4 can choose to draw a picture of something they would do at musical theatre camp instead of writing the essay. Please write the name of the entrant on the **BACK** of the essay or picture.

Mail or drop off entries **NO LATER THAN MONDAY, MAY 24** to the Charlotte Performing Arts Center Box Office (Attention: Hollie Auten) at 378 State St, Charlotte, MI 48813. A completed camp registration form and **FULL PAYMENT** for camp fees must accompany the entry. Those selected will be given a “rebate” of \$25 off the cost of tuition. Awards will be given to two individuals in the Broadway Kids Camp and two in the Broadway Teens Camp.
